MISSION TEAM NEWS COME celebrates 25 years! The month of April will be dedicated to SCOTT’S RUN SETTLEMENT HOUSE. Scott’s Run was founded in 1922 by Women of the Home Missionary Society to help immigrant families. They now serve families in Monongalia County who find themselves facing economic hardship. SRS has numerous programs including a Food Pantry, Backpack Feeding Program, Baby Pantry and Senior Food Box Program. In 2020, they helped over 9,000 families! One of the things I love most about SRS is they help determine the root cause of why a community member needs help. Then, they address the problem from job interview coaching to educational assistance. So, as you are shopping his week, think of the child picking up a backpack that will feed him until he returns to school on Monday, think on the baby that is losing weight because its formula is watered down to last longer. Keep in mind the senior on a fixed income that can't quite make it a whole month. Think on these things and FILL the basket! NEEDS LIST:

- **FOOD:** Canned foods, non-perishable food items
- **HOUSEHOLD:** dish soap, laundry detergent, cleaning supplies, soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrushes
- **BABY ITEMS:** diapers, wipes, baby soap, shampoo, lotion, diaper cream, formula, baby food, cereal. In His service, Gina
