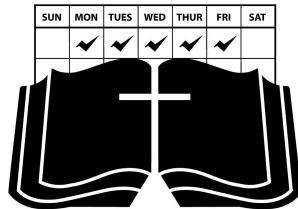

CELEBRATION OF MISSION EVENT - The COME is a time for in-gathering of goods for the 8 mission projects supported by the UM churches throughout WV. The event will be held on May 6th at First UMC in Huntington. Steele Memorial is part of the Western District and we have been asked to support HEART AND HAND HOUSE in Philippi, SCOTT'S RUN SETTLEMENT in Osage, and VOLUNTEERS IN MISSION (VMI).

In March, we accepted donations for Heart and Hand. During the month of April, we are collecting for Scott's Run. You may donate to VIM at any time. *****Please make your check payable to Steele Memorial with UVMIM #804 on the memo line so our church will receive credit for the donation.

SCOTT'S RUN SETTLEMENT HOUSE - This missionary outreach actually started in 1910 as a way to "Americanize" immigrants. It has grown over the years in response to the needs of the people of Monongalia County with programs and services that provide those in need with the most basic of needs.

Ongoing programs include a food pantry, baby basics pantry and a backpack feeding program that services 840 children! They also provide home repair and weatherization services. Seasonal outreach programs include a school supply giveaway, Thanksgiving baskets, Easter baskets, and family Christmas sponsorships. Needs are:

- Personal Care and Household Items, Baby items (diapers, sizes 3-6, baby food, formula, wipes), Personal hygiene items for men, women and children; household cleaning supplies/detergents
- Food Pantry: pasta, peanut butter, canned meat, canned milk, fresh, frozen or canned vegetables, spaghetti sauce, fresh, frozen or canned fruit, dried beans, cereal, butter, eggs, cheese
- Housing Program: Tools, drills, nail aprons, extension ladders, measuring tape, levels, brooms, paint rollers, tarps, volunteers
- General Office/Other: Postage stamps, copy paper, address labels, post-it notes, paper plates, cups, cooking utensils, and plastic utensils
- Backpack Snack Program: Single-serving canned fruit and vegetables, snack-size applesauce and puddings, canned pastas, individual servings of cereal, packets of instant oatmeal, shelf-stable milk boxes, dried fruits, whole grain cereal bars or granola bars(without nuts), snack-size bags of pretzels

VIM - VOLUNTEERS IN MISSION is a grassroots movement within the UMC for Christians to use their skills and talents in service at home and around the world on short term mission assignments at their own expense. This includes construction of mission facilities, teaching, witnessing, conducting medical clinics, bible study, bible school and disaster relief efforts around the world.
