

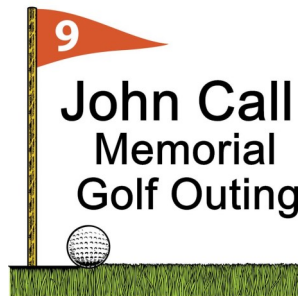

West Virginia lost 1,349 family members to fatal overdoses last year. This emphasis will be a welcome relief for some in our community who want to help save the lives of their children or their spouses from a possessing addiction! 1. A Community Greeter to welcome those who will attend from our Barboursville-area.
2. Site Leaders will help to coordinate shift volunteers and contribute to telling the story of the day by taking photos and posting on social media.
3. A Runner will help with transporting Naloxone from distribution sites that have excess if our site is running out.

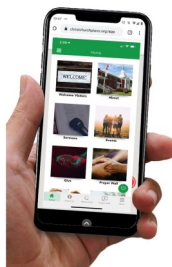
