West Virginia lost 1,349 family members to fatal overdoses last year. 2. Site Leaders will help to coordinate shift volunteers and contribute to telling the story of the day by taking photos and posting on social media.
3. A Runner will help with transporting Naloxone from distribution sites that have excess if our site is running out.

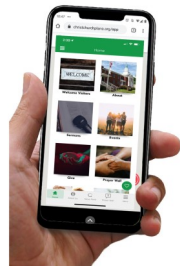
