For those at home, place your order by calling or texting Patty Mast at (419) 439-2260. The Scouts will deliver!

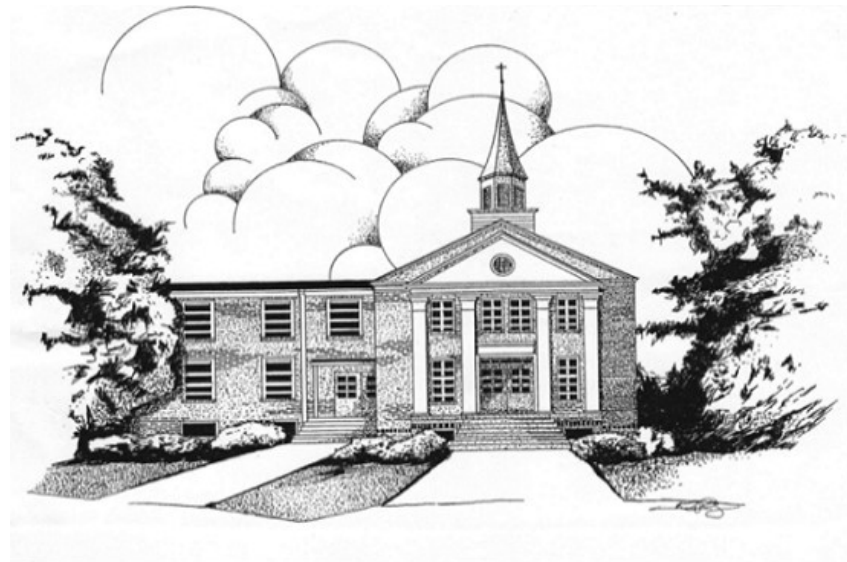
