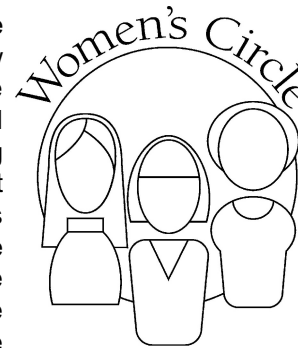

Plan now to pack a "Shoe Box" individually or with a group over the next few weeks. Additional information can be found in the pamphlet inside each empty shoebox or on the Samaritan's Purse Website. Thank you for taking part in this international children's mission project! (Durable plastic shoeboxes will be available in the Fellowship Classroom beginning Sunday, October 21. Final Collection Sunday - November 11.

In your shopping, you can focus on the age and gender of a child so that each box will be so labeled. We are told NOT to include - toothpaste, candy, gum, used or damaged items, war-related items, food, liquids or lotions, breakable or glass items or aerosol cans. SHIPPING donations have increased to \$9. Please include cash or a check inside the box, with the check made out to Samaritan's Purse. (The \$9 per box is a suggested donation. This donation is critical for Operation Christmas Child to collect, process and ship shoebox gifts to more than 100 countries. It also provides for ministry materials such as The Greatest Gift Gospel Booklet and The Ministry Partner Guide.)
