ADVENT Colored with Purple

The word Advent means "the coming or arrival of something or someone that is important or worthy of note; an arrival, especially one which is awaited." In the United Methodist Church, we prepare for Christmas, the birth of God's Savior, with the four Sundays before Christmas – known as our season of Advent.

Today, as we think about the "Advent" of Jesus Christ, we can think 1) in terms of His promised coming as foretold by God's messengers or prophets; we can think 2) of His immediate forerunner,

John the Baptizer, who announced the coming of the Savior; 3) we can also celebrate His actual arrival and appearance as God was formed as a human, born in Bethlehem; and 4) we include the coming of Christ in very personal ways, as He enters into the hearts of individuals who will make room for Him today!

So the story of the incarnate Son of God is told by prophets hundreds of years before His arrival, as well as by John, and others who prepared for Him in very special and personal ways, like Mary and Zechariah, and finally: YOU. How is He coming to you, in your home, in your heart this season?
