THE RED ROSES ON THE ALTAR are placed in celebration of the birth of:

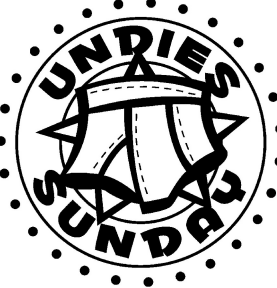
